CAMP RULES & REGULATIONS

1. No camper will be permitted to leave the campground without permission from the camp director.
2. Swimming is only allowed in the pool during scheduled times and under lifeguard supervision.
3. Conduct and speech exhibited at camp must be in keeping with Christian principles.
4. The use of alcohol, or tobacco products of any kind are absolutely forbidden.
5. Clothing worn at camp shall be in accordance with modest Christian attire. The camp director and staff can and will decide if the clothing is appropriate. Campers will be asked to change his or her clothes if they are deemed inappropriate. Inappropriate items include spaghetti straps, mid-riff/belly shirts, backless and strapless tops and cheerleading shorts. A rule of thumb is that all shorts should come below your fingertips when your arms are resting at your side.
6. Clothing that is offensive or advertises alcoholic beverages, drinking establishments, or tobacco is forbidden.
7. Male campers must keep their shirts on at all times except when inside the fence at the pool.
8. One-piece bathing suits, with bathing shorts. Two-piece bathing suits may be worn when covered with a T-Shirt that is not see through.
9. Gaming Systems, etc. are not allowed. (Appropriate music may be allowed for skits and special music projects, but must be approved and music players will be provided by counselors).
10. All phone calls (incoming and outgoing) will be limited to the free time hours and will be made at camp offices. Phone calls must be an emergency and approved by a counselor. (COUNSELOR or CAMP OFFICE PHONE will be used)
11. All camp rules will be enforced. The camp directors retain the right to send any camper home who refuses to adhere to camp rules.
12. **CELL PHONES WILL NOT BE PERMITTED DURING CAMP.** CAMPERS will hand in cellphones to leader or leave it home.
